the % change between each school's total NFF funding between 2019-20 & 2020-21 (this will also be influenced by changes in pupil numbers);

- the % change in each school's per pupil NFF funding between 2019-20 & 2020-21 (this will be influenced by changes in pupil numbers); - the % change in each school's pupil-led funding per pupil between 2019-20 & 2020-21 (this is the baseline we apply the funding floor to).

The figures set out below are not actual allocations. In 2020-21 local authorities (LAs) will continue to determine funding locally. LA level allocations in 2020-21 will reflect up to date pupil numbers.
